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ORDER:-

In the Government Order 1st read above, orders have been issued for converting 318 Tamil Nadu Integrated Projects (TINP) into General Integrated Child Development projects inclusive of 116 General Integrated Child Development Services Scheme Projects under World Bank Integrated Child Development Services Scheme Projects. Further, in 2003 both projects (318+116) were brought under the single Head of Department, i.e., Integrated Child Development Services Scheme headed by the then Project Coordinator and now the Director cum Mission Director as detailed below:-

a) Urban Projects	:	47

c) Tribal Projects	:	2

2. In the letter 2nd read above, Government of India have sanctioned 44 regular posts at State level i.e., Directorate of Integrated Child Development Services Scheme.

3. In the Government Order 3rd read above, Government have among others sanctioned 6 posts for the newly formed District Cell, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme, Thiruppur District such as District Programme Officer, Superintendent, Statistical Inspector, Assistant, Junior Assistant and Office Assistant which are further continued vide Government Order 12th read above.

4. In the Government Order 4th read above, Government accord sanction for further continuance of 43,103 temporary post sanctioned under the erstwhile world bank assisted Integrated Child Development Services Scheme – III Project for the further period from 01.04.2007 to 31.12.2009.

5. In the Government Order 6th read above, the following posts have been created.

6. In the letter 9th read above, Government of India have accepted/approved to operate with the existing staff strength with following instructions:

“Post sanctioned earlier by Government of India, which do not find place in the latest staffing pattern issued vide this Ministry’s letter of 08.05.2009 may henceforth, not be filled up as and when they fall vacant. The State Governments are requested to adhere to the Guidelines.”

7. In the Government Order 10th read above, orders have been issued towards the continuance of the 48,234 temporary posts for the period of two years from 01.01.2010 to 31.12.2012 which were lastly continued vide Government Orders 4th and 5th read above inclusive of 74 Supernumerary posts of Anganwadi Workers working as on 1.1.2010.

8. In the Government Order 11th read above, Government have created 6 posts such as District Programme Officer, Superintendent, Statistical Inspector, Assistant, Junior Assistant and Office Assistant for newly created District of Ariyalur towards the implementation of Integrated Child Development Scheme Services which were lastly continued in Government Order 17th read above.

9. In the letter 13th read above, Government of India have evolved Broad frame work for implementation of Integrated Child Development Services Scheme in the “Mission Mode” by strengthening and restructuring of Integrated Child Development Services Scheme. The Anganwadi Centre will be repositioned as a “Vibrant Early Childhood Development centre” to become the first village outpost for health, nutrition and to ensure holistic physical, psychosocial, cognitive and emotional development of children under 6 years of age in nurturing, protective, child friendly and gender sensitive family, community, programme and policy environments with greater emphasis on children under 3 and promotion of optimal early childhood care, development & learning including maternal care. Government of India have interalia provided additional human resources/technical manpower support at different levels.

10. In the Government Order 14th read above, orders have been issued towards the continuance of the 1,752 temporary posts after deleting one post of Programme Officer in the cadre of Deputy Director (Health) (since the post was kept vacant for more than 6 months) for the period of two years from 01.01.2012 to 31.12.2013 which were lastly continued in Government Orders 7th and 8th read above.

11. In the Government Order 15th read above, orders have been issued towards the continuance of the 52,600 the temporary posts for the period of two years from 01.01.2012 to 31.12.2013 which were lastly continued in Government Orders 7th and 8th read above.
